JUDGING ORDER

Judging order will be determined based on the pre-entries and the day of show entries. We will go by group and will order them in such a way as to allow people to leave as quickly as possible. The final judging order will be posted near each ring on the day of show.

CLASSES OFFERED

All regular UKC conformation classes will be offered for each breed offered. **Licensed Conformation classes consist of:**

A. Regular Classes. Classes for intact dogs: Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Senior (2yrs., under 3 yrs.); Adult (3 yrs. And up); Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Champion; and Grand Champion.

B. Altered Classes. Classes for altered dogs. Altered Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Altered Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Altered Senior (2yrs., under 3 yrs.); Altered Adult (3 yrs. And up); Altered Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Altered Champion; and Altered Grand Champion.

C. Junior Showmanship Classes. Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.); Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 6 yrs.); Pre-Junior (6 yrs., under 8); Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.); Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., up to & including 18 yrs.)

NOTE: Please check to make sure you are entering the correct class. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of their entry and for following UKC rules and regulations.

Group competition will be offered for all groups all four shows for both regular classes and altered classes. Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show, Best Altered in Show, Reserve Best Altered in Show will be awarded. A Best Junior in Show will be awarded.

Non-Licensed Classes – Novice Puppy, Veteran, Brace

- Novice Puppy, Veteran and Brace will be offered for all four shows. Non-licensed classes for each breed will be judged after the regular classes for each breed. At the end of the show, before the Best in Multi-Breed Show Competition, a Best in Show Novice Puppy competition, a Best in Show Veteran and a Best in Show Brace competition will be held. There will be no group offered for non-licensed classes.

ENTRIES

Pre-entries are \$22 for regular classes and \$5 for Junior Showmanship and Non-Licensed Classes. Pre-entries must be received WITH PAYMENT by March 23, 2018 or they will be charged day of show rates.

Weekend Pre-entry special: \$75 same dog all 4 shows

Day of show entries are \$28 for regular classes and \$10 for Junior Showmanship and Non-Licensed Classes.

All dogs entering these shows must be permanently registered with UKC, have a Limited Privilege (LP) listing number, or have a valid Temporary Listing Number. You can apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) on line at <https://www.ukcdogs.com/DEWebCom.nsf/TL%20Web?OpenForm>. If you have questions on registering your dog with UKC, go to the UKC Web site <http://www.ukcdogs.com> for more information.

All pre-entered dogs must be permanently registered with UKC or have an LP or TL by the closing date of the show. Any pre-entries that are received without this information provided by the closing date will be charged day of show entry fees.

We will be selling TL numbers the day of the show. The cost is \$20. If you are planning to purchase a TL number at the show, please arrive early enough to allow time for the purchase as well as your entry.

All entries must include fees. **Make all checks payable to UGSDA.**

Receipt of entries will be confirmed by e-mail if an e-mail address is provided on the entry form.

An un-entered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

No refund of entry fees will be made for pre-entries cancelled after the pre-entry closing date. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the UGSDA it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.

If, in the opinion of the UGSDA, the well being of dogs, exhibitors, or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightening or extreme heat, the UGSDA may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

CLASS CHANGES / CORRECTIONS

Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship or grand championship after the closing of entries, may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to the show secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show. The only exception to this is when two shows are running concurrently and a dog completes a championship in show 1. In that case, the request may be submitted any time before the start of judging of the breed in show 2. In the event that a breed is judged in show 2 prior to show 1 and a dog completes a championship in show 2, no move ups will be allowed for show 1.

All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the show secretary not later than ½ hour prior to the start of any regular judging at that show.

Pre-entries cannot be modified after the closing of pre-entries other than for move-ups and corrections. If a dog is entered in only some of the shows during a weekend (for example Saturday only) the entry cannot be modified to switch shows (for example switching to Sunday only).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc.
2. Absolutely no alcoholic beverage or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds on the day of a UKC-licensed event.
3. The UGSDA, its agents, UKC, its agents and its employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. The UGSDA and the UKC are not responsible for loss, accident, or theft.
4. Dogs and exhibitors may arrive at any time up to their judging time. Judging time is subject to change and exhibitors should be prepared to be judged any time after the start of the show. Dogs not required for further judging may leave the show grounds.
5. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
6. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a suitable length for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. Except as allowed by a dog's UKC breed standard, exhibitors are prohibited from altering coat color, coat texture, pigment color, ear carriage, tail carriage or any other essential element of the dog's conformation by any external means, including artificial color, foreign substances, or surgical means. Refer to the UKC Rules and Regulations for further information.
7. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or unzipped crate. X-pens will not be allowed in the building.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Refreshments will be available at the show site. Breakfast, snacks and lunch available both days.
2. There will be a raffle on site.
3. Building will be open to exhibitors at 7:15 a.m. Overnight security is not provided and no dog may be left in the building overnight.
4. There will be no admission or parking fee.

Near Broadway and Stinson, take the driveway on your right immediately AFTER the "BREDE" building.

The entrance to the training center is in the REAR of the building. (Technical Reproductions is in the front.)

(If you reach the Chippewa Water building, you've gone too far through the parking lot)
