CLASSES OFFERED

All regular UKC conformation classes will be offered for German Shepherds. **Licensed Conformation classes consist of:**

- A. Regular Classes. Classes for intact dogs:** Puppy (6 months-under 1 year); Junior (1 year-under 2 years); Adult (2 years & over); Open (6 months & over); Breeder & Handler (6 months & over shown by breeder); Champion (CH); Grand Champion (GRCH)
- B. Altered Classes. Classes for altered dogs:** Puppy (6 months-under 1 year); Junior (1 year-under 2 years); Adult (2 years & over); Open (6 months & over); Breeder & Handler (6 months & over shown by breeder); Champion (CH); Grand Champion (GRCH)
- C. Junior Showmanship Classes:** Pee Wee (2 years-under 4 years); Sub JR (4 years-under 6 years); Pre-Junior (6 years-under 8 years); Novice Junior (8 years-under 13 years); Open Junior (8 years-under 13 years); Novice Senior (13 years-18 years); Open Senior (13 years-18 years)
Junior Handlers entered in this specialty must be handling a German Shepherd Dog.

The following non-licensed conformation classes will be offered for German Shepherds. Refer to UKC rules for details on criteria for entering.

- Novice Puppy
- Veteran
- Brace
- Stud Dog
- Brood Bitch

Please check to make sure you are entering the correct class. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of their entry and for following UKC rules and regulations.

SPECIAL EXHIBITION CLASS

The United German Shepherd Dog Alliance recognizes the importance of the German Shepherd Dog as a versatile working breed. In this spirit, a special exhibition class will be held for dogs holding at least one UKC Performance title.

For the purposes of this class, we define a UKC performance title as follows:

Agility – UAGI or higher

Rally – URO1 or higher

Dock Diving – UNJ, UJJ, USJ, UMJ, UUU or higher

Obedience – UCD or higher

Weight Pull – UWP or higher

Nosework - NC, NI, NV, NE or higher

Dogs may be intact or altered. Dogs do not need to be entered in another class in the specialty to enter this class.

This class will not be judged but rather each dog will be recognized and receive a special rosette.

In order to enter this class, the owner must provide a list of the dog's UKC titles. **There is no charge for this class.**

PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded for

- Best Male/Female (regular and altered)
- Best of Winners (regular and altered)
- Champion of Champions (regular and altered)
- Grand Champion (regular and altered)
- Best of Breed (regular and altered)
- Best of Breed Novice Puppy
- Best of Breed Brace
- Best of Breed Stud Dog
- Best of Breed Brood Bitch
- Best of Breed Veteran

A special rosette will be given to all participants in the Special Exhibition class. Additional non-monetary prizes may be added at the discretion of the club.

ENTRIES

Pre-entries are \$20 for regular classes and \$10 for Non-Licensed Classes. Junior Showmanship is \$5. Pre-entries must be received WITH PAYMENT by June 7, 2021 or they will be charged day of show rates.

Day of show entries are \$25 for regular classes and \$10 for Non-Licensed Classes and Junior Showmanship. There is no charge for the special exhibition class but we ask that you pre-enter if possible to ensure we have enough awards.

All dogs entering these shows must be permanently registered with UKC, have a Limited Privilege (LP) listing number, or have a valid Temporary Listing Number. You can apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) on line at <https://www.ukcdogs.com/tl-numbers>. If you have questions on registering your dog with UKC, go to the UKC Web site <http://www.ukcdogs.com> for more information.

All pre-entered dogs must be permanently registered with UKC or have an LP or TL by the closing date of the show. Any pre-entries that are received without this information provided by the closing date will be charged day of show entry fees.

All entries must include fees. **Make all checks payable to UGSDA or paypal to ugsda@ugsda.org.**

Receipt of entries will be confirmed by e-mail if an e-mail address is provided on the entry form.

An un-entered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

No refund of entry fees will be made for pre-entries cancelled after the pre-entry closing date. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the UGSDA it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.

If, in the opinion of the UGSDA, the well being of dogs, exhibitors, or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightening or extreme heat, the UGSDA may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

CLASS CHANGES / CORRECTIONS

Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship or grand championship after the closing of entries, may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to the show secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show.

All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the show secretary not later than ½ hour prior to the start of any regular judging at that show.

Pre-entries cannot be modified after the closing of pre-entries other than for move-ups and corrections.
