Judge's briefing on both Saturday and Sunday will be at 7:45 AM.

Please note, AGI is now called Beginner Agility (BA), AGII is now called Intermediate Agility (IA). AGII is now called Excellent Agility (EA). DT refer to the new Dynamic Tunnelers Class.

Running order will be sent out prior to the trial in a confirmation letter.

ENTRIES

Pre-entries close August 25, 2021. No day of show entries will be taken.

Entry fees: All classes are \$18.

Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, or have a Limited Privilege (LP) listing number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.

All pre-entered dogs must be permanently registered with UKC or have an LP or TL by the closing date of the trial. Any pre-entries that are received without this information provided by the closing date will be charged day of show entry fees.

All entries must include fees. **Make all checks payable to UGSDA.**

Receipt of entries will be confirmed by e-mail if an e-mail address is provided on the entry form.

An un-entered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

No refund of entry fees will be made for pre-entries cancelled after the pre-entry closing date. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If a pre-entered female comes into season after pre-entries have closed, we will refund the entry fee minus a \$3 per trial processing fee provided the trial secretary is notified prior to the start of the trial.

If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the UGSDA it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.

If, in the opinion of the UGSDA, the well being of dogs, exhibitors, or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightening or extreme heat, the UGSDA may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

CLASS CHANGES / CORRECTIONS

Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry.

Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to the show secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the trial.

All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the show secretary not later than ½ hour prior to the start of any regular judging at that trial.

Pre-entries cannot be modified after the closing of pre-entries other than for move-ups and corrections. If a dog is entered in only some of the trials during a weekend (for example Saturday only) the entry cannot be modified to switch trials (for example switching to Sunday only).

Please note! There are A and B divisions in BA and IA. UACH points are awarded in B division only. Please consult the UKC regulations as to which division you should enter. They are available at <http://www.ukcdogs.com>.

AWARDS

The following awards will be given at this trial:

- Qualifying ribbons for all qualifying scores
- Ribbons for 1st-4th place
- Rosettes for New Titles – UACH and higher will receive championship bars as well
- Rosette for High in Trial, High in Trial Junior and High Scoring German Shepherd
- Award for High in Trial Veteran

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc.
2. Absolutely no alcoholic beverage or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds on the day of a UKC-licensed event.

3. The UGSDA, its agents, UKC, its agents and its employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume not responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. The UGSDA and the UKC are not responsible for loss, accident, or theft.
4. Dogs and exhibitors may arrive at any time up to their judging time. Judging time is subject to change and exhibitors should be prepared to be judged any time after the start of the trial. Dogs not required for further judging may leave the trial grounds.
5. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
6. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or unzipped crate.
